Initial development, 2011-2014 (Brown Univ)

- Build and test user interface
- Begin recruiting users, further needs assessment

Repository development, 2014-2017 (Northeastern Univ)

- Build repository and XML functions
- Re-engineer UI in Hydra
- Update user interface

TAPAS Classroom, 2016-2017

- Expand view packages
- Develop support for instructors
